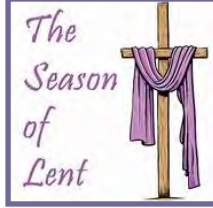

From Ash Wednesday, Feb. 14th until Thursday, March 29th, the Catholic Church throughout the world commemorates the penitential season of Lent.

The model Jesus gave us for "these 40 days" was his own experience in the desert and the temptations that followed him there where he encountered Satan face to face. And yet, Jesus, there in the desert, alone, fasting and in intense prayer, beat back the devil and triumphed over temptation, as strong and as unrelenting as it was throughout those 40 days.

We enter the desert of Lent like Jesus, led by the Holy Spirit, to face our devils, our temptations head on. But we are not alone. Jesus is with us. And so, too, is the Church, the entire community of faith observing Lent.

Lenten rules for baptized Catholics:

Days of fast (*only one full meal*) and abstinence (*no meat*) are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

All other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence (*no meat*).

Those of us between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast. Those of us 14 years of age and older are obliged to abstain from meat on those days of abstinence listed above.

This Sunday's 2nd collection will include the annual Diocesan collection in support of the Catholic Churches in Central and Eastern Europe.

This collection supports the Church in over 25 countries that are still struggling to recover in the aftermath of communist rule. Monies from this collection support pastoral care, catechesis, building renovations, and seminary formation. Our support restores the Church and builds the future in this region.
