**Evangelization**

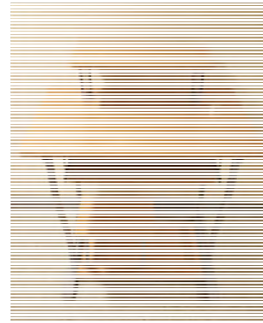

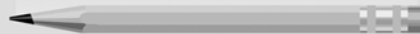
