Join in St. Catharine's  
"Cloth of Remembrance"

The Rosary Altar Society/Arts Crafts Committee invite our parishioners to join in the Lenten journey at St. Catharine's by creating a "Cloth of Remembrance". 6"x 6" squares of

cloth will be provided that will represent a prayer request, sorrow or particular hardship you would like to be remembered. The squares will be in baskets at the E Street and Central Avenue foyers. You may bring your own 6" x 6" square of cloth that has a special meaning to you, perhaps from a loved ones blanket, clothing, etc. You may write your need on the cloth or leave it plain. Indelible pens will be in the baskets for you to personalize if you choose.

Place your finished cloth in the return basket. Throughout the Lenten season the ladies will collect the squares and join them together to be draped over the crucifix during the Holy Week services.
