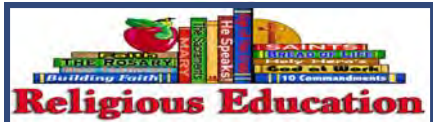

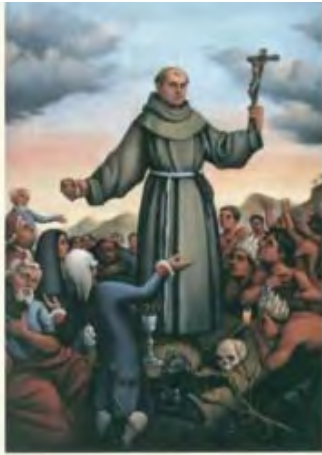

Dear Parishioners,

Our Bishop, David O'Connell, has announced the name of our new parish resulting from the merger of St. Catharine's and Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Seaside Heights as the Parish of St. Junipero Serra!

St. Junipero Serra was an 18th century Order of Friars Minor Franciscan (aka 'Brown Franciscans') priest who evangelized Native American Indians and founded mission churches in the wilderness of California.

Originally from Majorca, Spain, St. Junipero was born on November 24, 1713 and entered into eternal life on August 28, 1784. Junipero was beatified by Pope John Paul II on September 25, 1988 in the Vatican, and he was canonized a saint on September 23, 2015 by Pope Francis in the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C., during Pope Francis' first visit to the United States, the very first canonization to take place on American soil.

St. Junipero's feast day is celebrated on July 1st. He is the patron saint of California, Hispanic Americans, and religious vocations.

Our new Parish of St. Junipero Serra will be formed this July 1st, 2018, Junipero's feast day! What a happy coincidence! Let us pray to St. Junipero that he will help our new parish under his patronage to grow and flourish here on the east coast as he sowed the seeds of the Church in the 18th century New World on the west coast.
