March 24th.*

The purpose of this mini-workshop is to train those Eucharistic Ministers who wish to serve as a leader of prayer for Eucharistic celebrations in the absence of a priest, when a priest is not available, be it on a Sunday or for a weekday scheduled Mass.

Hopefully, we'll never need a Eucharistic Minister to lead a Eucharistic celebration in the absence of a priest, but we should be prepared for such an occasion.

Father John has revised the handout from our March 24th meeting so, hopefully, the sequence of the liturgy will be easier to follow, and with less books. We'll critique the newer handout and make improvements again where necessary.

If you are a Eucharistic Minister who'd rather not lead a Eucharistic celebration in the absence of a priest, you do not have to attend this mini-workshop.
