Dear Parishioners,

Hopefully you were present at Mass last weekend to hear Bruce Polcino's update on our Capital Campaign "Where Faith & Community Grow".

This just-past July 4th weekend we entered into our 3rd year of this 5 year Campaign. How quickly time passes us by!

Thank you to all who've contributed to this very necessary Campaign already! Thank you for your sacrifice and generosity! If you have not as yet pledged or contributed to the Campaign, please know that we still very much need your help!

As of July 4, 2017: \$630,574.04 has been pledged! Bishop O'Connell has already received our contribution of \$378,000.00 owed toward his "Faith to Move Mountains" Campaign. Any monies now pledged or donated to our "Where Faith & Community Grow" Campaign remain here at St. Catharine's!

Since we are still short of our goal, and short of the funds needed to renovate our parish hall, the Finance Committee in agreement with our Pastoral Council and myself, have decided to deplete our savings in order to get going with the actual renovation which will include the new heating and air conditioning system.

Both our current hall heating and air conditioning systems are unreliable and must be replaced. Hopefully, you've had a chance to view the old units on the monitors in our church foyers. The monitors also show the damage in both the attic and the basement of the hall, areas of the building most of us never actually see.

I hope also that you've had the chance over wine and cheese on Saturday, or coffee and donuts on Sunday morning, to take a look at the sketches of what the new St. Catharine's Community Center will look like. What an improvement!

With your generous support our dream of a safer, more functional space for so many of our Parish activities will soon be a reality we can all enjoy.
