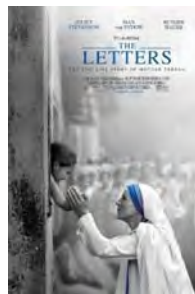
ELECTRAFLAMES

Thinking about changing your residence to Florida for tax reasons?

Many residents have considered changing their domicile and moving out of New Jersey due to our high overall tax structure. Gov. Christie recently signed a bill reducing some of this burden.

First, the tax bill includes a phase-out of the estate tax which will be eliminated as of January 1, 2018. However, the New Jersey inheritance tax will remain unchanged.

Second, the amount of retirement income taxpayers may exclude from taxable income will rise in increments over four years by January 1, 2020 to a \$100,000 exclusion.

High-net-worth individuals and those considering changing their domicile should review their tax and estate planning documents with a tax or legal professional to discuss how the change in the New Jersey tax law impacts their individual situation.

St. Catharine's has planned a session after all Masses on Nov. 12th and 13th. Planning professionals with financial and estate tax literature will be present at these sessions.
