Members of our Campaign Leadership Committee met with our CCD parents last month, all of whom are naturally in favor of the renovations to our parish hall. The committee met again following that meeting to discuss future planning for the Campaign now in its second year.

It was decided that letters of encouragement be sent out to parishioners who've not as yet pledged to the Campaign. We'll also place video screens in the church foyers which will feature the progress of the Campaign, as well as pictures of the interior of the parish hall. Sections of the attic and basement not seen by most visitors to the parish hall, and badly in need of renovation, will be included for public viewing. Hopefully, the pictures will help generate support for this needed undertaking.

One clarification: monies pledged for our Capital Campaign "Where Faith & Community Grow" for the purpose of renovating our parish hall are not being used in the current renovations to the friary. The installation of the new elevator, generator, and other major improvements to the friary are all being paid for by the Conventual Franciscan Community, Fr. John's religious order.

The friars of Our Lady of the Angels Province who use St. Catharine's Friary as one of the friar's retirement homes felt it was important to install the elevator and make other improvements for the elderly retired friars who live here. We are grateful to the Franciscan Friars for their generosity and concern for the friars, old and not-so-old, who minister here at St. Catharine's.
